



## NOTICE TO VICTORIA AND ESQUIMALT BUSINESSES AND RESIDENTS

On July 1st, Victoria's Canada Day event will bring up to 60,000 people to Victoria's Inner Harbour and Legislative Precinct; the event will be presented by the City of Victoria and produced by Rifflandia Entertainment Company (REC).

Canada Day will include musical performances and cultural programming, family activities, and a global food village. Scheduled programming will be carried out throughout the day on July 1st beginning at 11:00 AM and concluding at 10:15 PM. Following the conclusion of the regular event program the evening will be topped off with a drone light show designed by local Indigenous artist Rande Cook and a spectacular firework display both of which will be launched over the Inner Harbour.

This closure will occur between 6:00 AM on July 1 through 8:00 AM on July 2.

**Government St. from Belleville St. to Humboldt St.**

This closure will occur between 12:00 PM on July 1 through 11:00 PM on July 1.

**Belleville St. from Oswego St. to Menzies St.**

This will be local traffic only from 6:00 AM on July 1 through 11:00 PM on July 1.

**Songhees Rd. from Tyee Rd. to Kimta Rd.**

This closure will occur between 9:30 PM on July 1 through 11:00 PM on July 1.

**Bike lane closures:**

**Belleville St. between Government St. and Menzies St.**

This closure will occur between 6:00 AM on July 1 through 8:00 AM on July 2.

**Menzies St. from Belleville St. to Quebec St.**

This closure will occur between 6:00 AM on July 1 through 8:00 AM on July 2.

**Government St. from Belleville St. to Humboldt St.**

This closure will occur between 12:00 PM on July 1 through 11:00 PM on July 1.

**Belleville St. from Oswego St. to Menzies St.**

This will be local traffic only from 6:00 AM on July 1 through 11:00 PM on July 1.

**Songhees Walkway Bike Lane**

**Parking restrictions:**

**Menzies St. from Belleville St. to Quebec St.**

This area will be a no parking zone from 12:00 PM on June 28 through 12:00 PM on July 3.

**East Menzies St. from Quebec St. to Kingston St.**

This area will be permit-only event parking from 12:00 PM on June 28 through 12:00 PM on July 3.

**Menzies St. from Quebec St. to Superior St.**

This area will be permit-only event parking from 6:00 AM on June 30 through 12:00 PM on July 2.

**Quebec St. from Menzies St. to Oswego St.**

This area will be permit-only event parking from 6:00 AM on July 1 through 6:00 AM on July 2.
